Rich cherry and black currant aromas lure you in, with light overtones of dried fig and sensuous chocolate. This Cabernet Sauvignon is abundant with concentrated fruit flavors and nicely balanced with smooth caramel, creamy oak and vanilla accents that lead to a pleasant finish.
