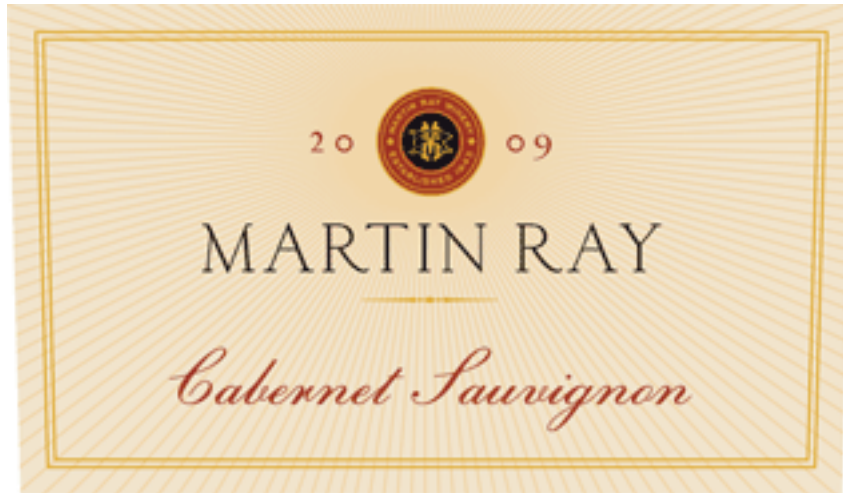


2009 Martin Ray Napa-Sonoma-Mendocino Counties Cabernet Sauvignon

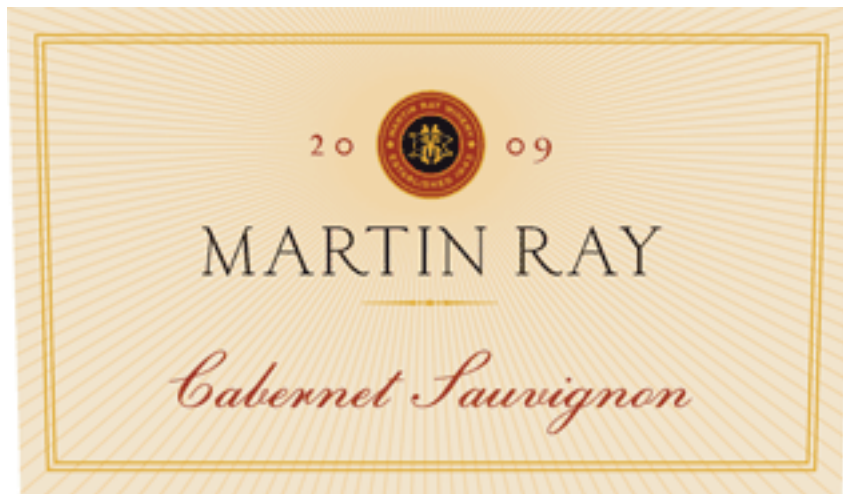

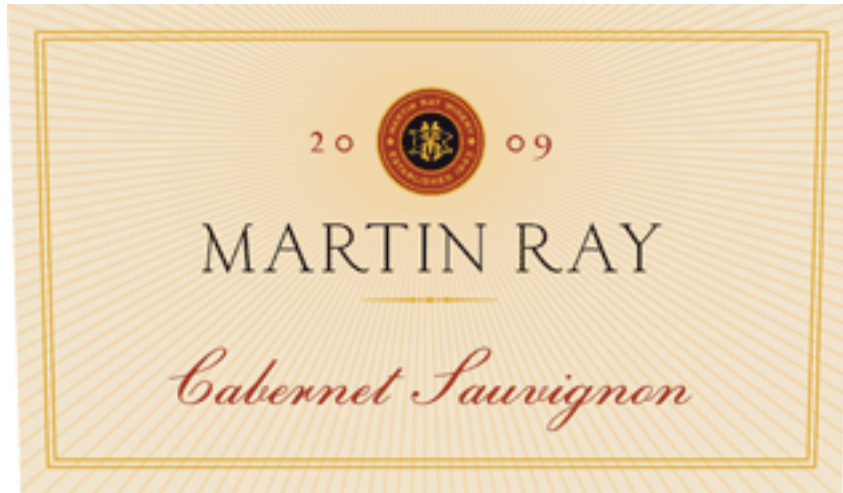

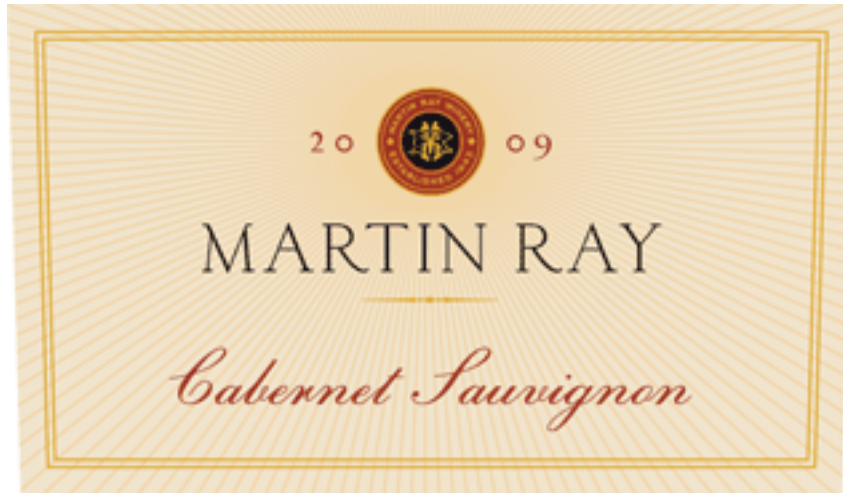
