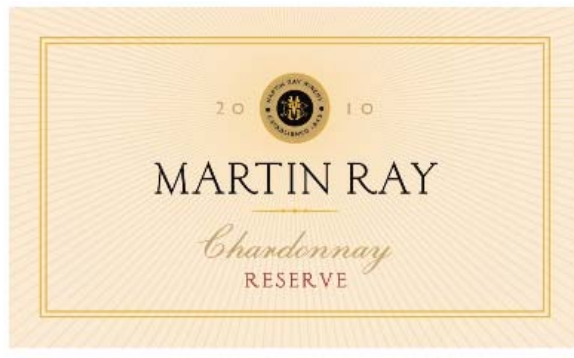
2010 Martin Ray Reserve Santa Cruz Mountains- Bald Mountain Chardonnay

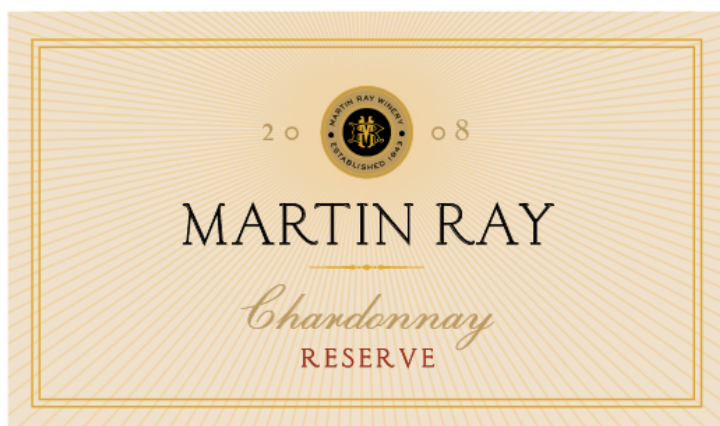

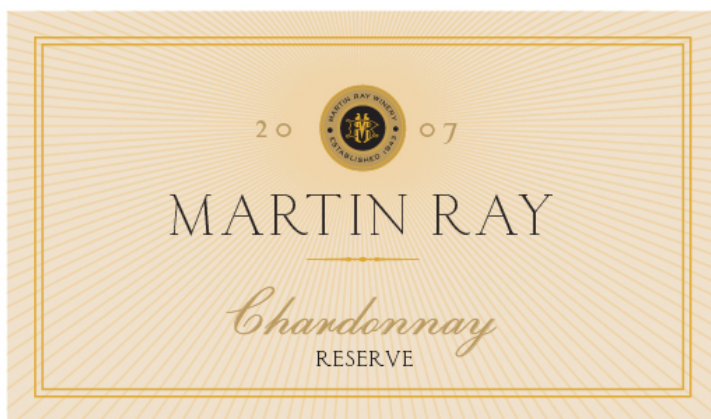
