TASTING NOTES

2011 Martin Ray Un-oaked Chardonnay, Los Carneros Mouthwatering aromas of green apple, Meyer lemon and savory green herbs are enhanced by clean mineral notes. This refreshing Chardonnay is clean and crisp in the mouth, with lingering flavors of apple, citrus and herbs. Zesty!

Angeline 2011 Pinot Noir Reserve This pretty Pinot is loaded with aromas and flavors of fresh, ripe cranberry and dried red cherry, with a soft berry mouth and a long, delicious finish.

Martin Ray 2009 Cabernet Sauvignon, Sonoma County Soft, sweet clove overtones back aromatics thick with smoky vanilla and a whisper of anise. This pretty and intense wine is full of dark, lightly smoked, sweet fruit, layered with rich texture.

Courtney Benham 2011 Napa Valley Merlot Complex aromas of plum, spice potpourri, dried rose petals, coffee and vanilla continue as flavors in the velvety soft mouth and linger through the finish.

INEMAKING & VINEYARD NOTES

For the 2012 vintage, we are adding some new vineyards into our program. We have some new Dry Creek Valley, Green Valley, and Sonoma Coast Chardonnay in the mix, as well as some Green Valley and Russian River Valley Pinot Noir and a new Atlas Peak Cabernet vineyard. We are very excited about these sites and are thrilled at the prospect of bringing in more high quality fruit.

Our own vineyard is being re-established this year. The focus for replanting is to create a high-end, traditional Dijon-clone Pinot Noir vineyard on our beautiful estate soil. We have changed our row orientation to a more appropriate diagonal design, and we planted dormant bench grafts on 101-14 Millardet et de Grasset rootstock.

In striving for complexity in our estate Pinot, we have planted various clones. While our vineyard will predominantly consist of tried-and-true Dijon clones 115, 667, and 777, we are also experimenting with a small amount of a more recently recognized clone, 943. This 943 is another traditional Burgundy clone with a long history of excellent quality in France, but has only recently been imported to the U.S. It is typically described as having tiny berries with more concentrated color and red berry flavor, yet creates a smoother, balanced wine.

On another exciting note, our small block adjacent to the new event pavilion is being planted to UCD Clone 37, which is also known as the Mount Eden Clone or the Merry Edwards Selection. This clone is special to us because it was originally planted at Paul Masson's Martin Ray vineyards, now Mount Eden estate vineyard, in Santa Cruz Mountains AVA.

In other news, we have fully renovated a portion of our winery for use as a high-end "microwinery". We have also invested in an egg-shaped tank to be used in small lot fermentation experiments, a new bank of open top tanks, another fruit sorting table, and other exciting equipment, to make our 2012 harvest all the more interesting and geared toward detail.
