The 2008 Courtney Benham Sauvignon Blanc is produced from selected vineyards in the Lake County appellation. This wine exhibits the richness and classic varietal flavors that come from this region. Warm days and cool nights provide favorable growing conditions for the vineyards in the appellation.

WINENOTES

This crisp, tangy wine is 100% cool fermentation in stainless steel tanks to preserve the fresh fruit aromas, combined with a portion in French oak. Inviting tropical aromas of light floral and green melon. Crisp and lively flavors of fresh green melon continue in this wine. This classic, full wine has an ample palate with lingering bright flavors of refreshing fruit.
