The grapes for Courtney Benham Diamond Mountain District Cabernet Sauvignon are grown on the spectacular Diamond Mountain Vineyard, which rises to 2200 feet elevation above the Napa Valley floor. This unique mountain vineyard site provides a variety of soils, superior sun exposure and nighttime cooling; producing small, intense, full-flavored berries.

WINE NOTES

Our Diamond Mountain Cabernet Sauvignon is a tightly wound wine with a rich, concentrated structure. Enticing aromas and flavors of sumptuous cherries, blackberries and ripe plums are accented with hints of vanilla oak, which lead to a long, rich finish.
