## 2006 NAPA VALLEY SAUVIGNON BLANC

THE MARTIN RAY 2006 NAPA VALLEY SAUVIGNON BLANC is made from grapes carefully selected from vineyards in the acclaimed Yountville appellation of Napa Valley. Rich fruit characteristics and lush tropical fruit flavors emerge from these select grapes, which are picked from some of the finest vineyards in the region.

The 2006 harvest was an excellent vintage for Napa County. After a cool, wet spring, the vintage moved along quite slowly. This longer than normal ripening period allowed the vines to produce mature, intense fruit without high sugars.

Our Martin Ray Sauvignon Blanc was partially aged in French oak barrels, resulting in a rich, yet refreshing wine. Fruity aromatics lead to flavors of ripe melon, luscious peach and tangy grapefruit. This wine is full and rich on the palate with good structure and crisp, fresh fruit flavors.
