2004 NAPA VALLEY RESERVE CABERNET SAUVIGNON

THE VINEYARDS The 2004 Martin Ray Napa Valley Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon is produced from selected vineyards in the acclaimed Napa Valley wine region. The vineyards include grapes from Atlas Peak, De Mar, the Stags Leap District and the Diamond Mountain District. These highly sought after vineyards produce grapes of great intensity and flavor.

VINTAGE NOTES The 2004 harvest was extremely favorable and produced a wealth of high quality fruit. A steady growing season with mild temperatures throughout the year allowed for the grapes to ripen to full maturity two weeks earlier than usual. These conditions, coupled with a rain-free ripening season, have resulted in a vintage of vibrant color, concentrated flavors and beautiful aromatics.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES Our Napa Valley Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon is aged for 22 months in French oak barrels. This oak-driven Cabernet Sauvignon has aromas of ripe, dark plum and cherries. Bright flavors of black cherry, plum and creamy vanilla oak lead to a full fruit finish.

FOOD & WINE PAIRING Grilled tri-tip with rosemary or pasta with a beef Bolognese sauce.
